Greetings of Shalom to all our friends and faithful prayer partners for Association of Christians for the Protection of Orphans (ACPO) and Mountain of Praise Church (MOP).

As I am listening to the Mountain of Praise and ACPO orphan's choir singing: "Lord, help Africa: come Holy Spirit", I am encouraged, knowing that the Lord holds the whole world in his hands. (to hear this choir, go to my Facebook page—I reposted the choir singing on Nov 1)

As I think over the 27 years that I have been privileged to serve the Lord among the orphans, the widows, and the poorest of the poor, I marvel what the Lord has done. With your help we continue to rescue, protect, and nurture children who have come to ACPO, most of the time from very difficult situations. I will share some of those situations with you all and pray that you can hear our plea for generous help to continue caring for so many children.

Macani is the leader for the children's choir and teaches Bible stories at Mountain of Praise Church. When he was 10 years old, he came with his two sisters, who were 12 and 17 years old, to the mission (ACPO) in March of 2017. They



lived in Dondo when they were brought to the police by the social services.

They no longer were able to live with their father because he had abused them. The sisters left ACPO and Macani stayed with us. He is actively involved and helps in the mission. Another boy assists Macani in teaching the children Bible stories and leading the choir. This is an example of transformed lives in the ACPO children's community.



Xady and Isabel arrived with their father, coming almost from the border between Mozambique and Malawi. They lost their mother when they were still small, and since their father could not take care of them and go to work at the same time, he came to the government to seek help. The government

referred them to ACPO in 2021. The father now works with the corn mill, so he (Mr. Jaime Botoman) and the children are under the care of ACPO.

I thank you all for how you continue to support us with your prayers and finances so we can rescue and help children in danger.



These two widows work with ACPO mission and are holding two children. One was found abandoned on the streets and the other was brought to the orphanage because the mother could not care for her - the mother was mentally impaired and wasn't able. So these two children were brought to our orphanage. I thank the Lord there is a place to rescue a child who is left abandoned on the streets. The children have gone to their families now, but I leave it as part of the newsletter to show how you are helping us rescue children in incredibly difficult and dangerous situations.

Belinha Cipriano (13 years old) left Mugeba-Zambezia with her aunt for Dondo, where her aunt gave the girl to a friend and in turn this friend abandoned her. Social Action brought Belinha to ACPO in 2023.



Sara Joaquim was found on the public road in Dondo in 2023, and she said that she left Beira where she lived with her aunt. She came to Dondo to look for her brother, and she does not know where that brother lives and has no information for the authorities to locate this brother.

Thank you to Harvest Community Church's Vacation Bible School for giving a generous gift so that chairs, two tables, and a lockable cabinet could be built for the children in the nursery school.



Pastor Rego sends his love and a big thank you to all who are praying for him and those who have helped him financially get therapeutic treatment.
